

NOTICE TO WATER SYSTEM USERS

MONITORING VIOLATION

The Municipality of Anchorage, Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility, I.D. AK2210906, is required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. For the timeframe(s) listed below, we did not meet our monitoring requirements for the chemicals listed below, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water at that time.

Contaminant	Frequency (sites in noncompliance)	Noncompliance Timeframe	Return to Compliance
Total Gross Alpha	One sample per nine year cycle (1 site)	2008-2016	12/22/17
Radium 226 & 228	One sample per nine year cycle (11 sites)	2008-2016	12/26/17
Nitrate	One sample annually (1 site)	2016	10/31/17

At this time:

- Our required samples have been collected for this monitoring period.
- Samples will be collected in the future as required.

Other information for customers: We expect there to be no adverse health risk to any population, including particularly vulnerable subpopulations. Historical MCL levels have been well below any health concern. New results are significantly below any health risk and at or below detectable levels. We will be implementing a new monitoring schedule system which should prevent this type of monitoring oversight in the future.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
